These values underpin everything that the club does and forms the basis of acceptable behaviour whilst attending the club. The Out There Club has a zero tolerance policy on alcohol, drugs and bullying.

If club staff witness behaviour we view to be unacceptable, we will initially challenge it in a positive way on an individual basis with the young person in question.

If behaviour continues to be deemed unacceptable in relation to any of the above 5 Respect points or behaviour is such that we cannot guarantee an individual's safety, then the participant maybe asked to leave the activity session.

Any future continuation at the club will be considered by the committee. The Out There Club committee reserves the right to terminate membership or refuse a membership application or renewal.
